A resident stated that she felt it was vital for the village of New Longton that a bus service was retained. She felt that the young, old and those without cars needed a bus service to attend college, doctors, dentist and churches to name but a few. She was supported by other residents present although one did remark that on some services there was little usage and that a balance had to be maintained and should only be provided to meet need.

## It was then resolved that the public should be excluded from the following item under the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960 due to the confidential nature of the business to be discussed.

13/16 To consider whether this Council should now go ahead with the provision of funding to provide a replacement bus service for New Longton (papers have already been circulated with full details) Tom Calderbank from Preston Bus was present to go through the proposals for members which were outlined in the papers that had already been circulated and are now held on file.

It was resolved that this Council should go ahead with the provision of funding to the extent of £50K in order to replace the current bus service for New Longton which was at threat due to LCC's likely subsidy withdrawal.
